District and School Level Support for Students with Challenging Behaviors

The goal of this service is to provide guidance to district and school staff who could use coaching and support with challenging student behaviors in the school and/or classroom. Support may include:

- Facilitation by IMESD staff of a connection between school staff (teachers, counselors, administrators, etc.) and service providers according to the student's need.
- An action plan for interventions based on school/district plans, programs, resources (i.e. Conscious Discipline, PBIS, Collaborative Problem Solving, Restorative Justice, Positive Discipline, Trauma-Informed Practices, Student Support Team Process, Behavior Plans, etc.)
- On-going follow up and support as needed.
